Joel McMullen is the head men's and women's cross country coach and the compliance officer at Eastern New Mexico University in Portales, N.M. McMullen began his duties in July, 2004.

"Eastern has a tremendous history in the sport of cross country," Coach McMullen said. "Winning national championships in 1973 and 1974 was a tremendous accomplishment and it is amazing that many of the track and cross country records here at ENMU still stand from that era. It is our goal to restore the glory, pride and success that once existed here. My staff and I will do everything we can to return ENMU cross country to that level once again."

ENMU placed fourth in the men's race and seventh in the women's race at the 2005 LSC Championships. The Hounds took eighth and the Zias were 16th at the NCAA Regionals.

Prior to arriving at ENMU, McMullen was at Oklahoma State University as a compliance assistant. He also consulted with the Cowboys' cross country coaching staff that has enjoyed great success under Head Coach Dick Weis.

McMullen ran cross country and distance events in track throughout his high school career at Great Bend HS (Kan.). He also competed in





Boit Earns All-Conference Honors as ENMU Achieves its Most Successful Cross Country Season Since Joining the NCAA

Cross country runner Felix Boit (Fr.) earned First Team All-Lone Star Conference honors with a 10th place finish at the 2005 LSC Cross Country Championships. Boit's 26:59.1 for the 8-kilometer course led the Greyhounds to fourth place, the highest finish in team history. The Zias took seventh, led by Joyce Doan (Jr.) in 24th place with a time of 24:57.8 over the 6-kilometer course.

ENMU entered the NCAA Division II South Central Regionals ranked ninth in the Region in men's cross country. Eastern took eighth place in the men's division for the first-ever Top 10 finish by the Greyhounds since ENMU joined the NCAA. Boit, challenged for a Top 12 finish in hopes of qualifying for the National Championships. He gave all he had, collapsed 100 meters from the finish line and slipped to 31st place with a 10-kilometer time of 35:12.45. Jason Garcia (So.) was Eastern's first finisher, earning 20th place in 34:39.75. Eastern's women took 16th place at the Regional Meet. The top Zia was Doan, who clocked in at 25:05.40 for 41st place over the 6-kilometer course.

Earlier in the season, the Greyhounds took first place as a team at the N.M. Highlands Invitational and the South Plains College Cross Country Festival. At Highlands, the Hounds finished in front of Adams State, the #1 team in the NCAA Division II National Rankings. Eastern took second place at the West Texas A&M Buffalo Stampede, finishing three points behind Angelo State. ENMU also claimed second place at the New Mexico State Kachina Classic, where the Hounds trailed only UTEP.

Boit took first place overall at South Plains, while Garcia and Orlando Sanchez (Sr) followed immediately in second and third. Garcia was sixth at New Mexico Highlands and Boit was third at WTAMU, sixth at Oklahoma State and eighth at NMSU.

Doan placed 14th in the women's race at Highlands. She was eighth at South Plains to lead the Zias to a third place finish. Stacy Salazar (Fr.) earned a 14th place finish at New Mexico State.
